"The 'GSM' is a silky blend of Grenache (41%), Syrah (15%) and Mourvedre (41%). The smoky and meaty elements from the Mourvedre are evident right now, as is the pretty floral edge from the Grenache. This has a great combination if weigh, tension and salinity, as this beautiful wine covers a really good range of red dark fruits with a smoky character from the Mourvedre.
