

2010 ROSÉ

Red Mountain

Tasting Notes

Aromas of fresh strawberry, ripe watermelon, pomegranate and white flowers lead through to the palate with a creamy yet firm finish. The structure of Red Mountain should allow this rose to age well for the next 2-5 years.

Vintage

One of the coolest vintages of the last decade, about 10-14 days later than 2009. Wines exhibit wonderful color and great structure.

Vineyards

100% Red Mountain - Kiona Vineyards

Winemaking

Juice was racked off after just two hours of skin contact. Fermented in neutral French oak barrels. Wine remained in barrel on gross lees for 7 months, stirred every two weeks. 60% Syrah, 40% Cabernet Sauvignon.
